

Pumpkin Topiary

Supplies:

- ✿ A large terra cotta pot
- ✿ Some plaster or rocks (to weigh it down)
- ✿ 3 different sizes of foam pumpkins
- ✿ A dowel to hold the pumpkins together
- ✿ Finishing touches: fall foliage (vines and picks), grapevine, Sunflowers, berries, spanish moss, and whatever else you like!
- ✿ Hot Glue



Directions:

To make this you will fill the pot with plaster or rocks. Make sure to have the dowel where you want it to be.

Next you will prepare the pumpkins to be stacked. The larger two pumpkins need to have the stems cut off so the surface is flat.

Then drill holes on the top and bottom of the bottom 2 pumpkins and only on the bottom of the top pumpkin. Make sure they are straight. Drill the hole slightly smaller than the dowels so they fit snug.

Now put the pumpkins together. String the pumpkins on the dowel gluing with the hot glue as you go. After all of the pumpkins are on, glue the spanish moss where the pumpkins connect to hide the seam. Finish by adding your accents, gluing as you go.
